Ethics Application and Submission Requirements



Project/proposal submissions to the Sioux Lookout Meno Ya Win Health Centre (SLMHC) Research Review and Ethics Committee (RREC), requesting ethics approval must be a maximum of ten (10) pages in length, including patient information and consent sheet.

Any changes/revisions to projects/proposals require RREC approval prior to implementation. Please include information for each of the following in order:

Research Team

Principal Investigator and team Information; contact information and signature

Research Project/Proposal Information

1. Project Title
2. Research Question: one or two sentences.
3. Project Description: with relevant background information.
4. Research Design: including methodology, data collection, recruitment, and confidentiality
5. TCPS2 and OCAP®: How will the project comply with and meet TCPS2 and OCAP® principles?
6. Potential Risk: Are there perceived potential risks to participants or researchers?
7. Potential Benefit: What are the potential benefits from the project/proposal?
8. Patient information and consent sheet(s) must accompany the submission: needs short, uncomplicated, accessible language.

This information may be used as a guide for project/proposal submission.

Proposals may be submitted as word documents, PDF, or as hard copy.

A fillable application form, which outlines the format, is also available on the SLMHC website under Research.
